

Parents Night Out Guidelines:

1. FEVERS: Children must be fever free for 24 hours before coming to Parents Night Out.

2. Child Watchers: We have 3 couples for a reason, the possibility of having 50 kids is very real, BOTH people in the couple MUST be there. If your spouse cannot come, you need to call a friend or relative to come with you, please DO NOT show up with just one spouse. ALSO, please be responsible with the dates you are assigned, if you cannot make your date, please trade with someone. If you cannot find anyone, please call me, Kelli Edwards, and I unfortunately will have to CANCEL Parents Night Out. PNO affects a lot of couples so please try to find a replacement.

3. If any parents have any old board games, puzzles, or LEGOS, that you would like to donate, please bring them to Parents Night, we would love to have them in our box!

4. Behavior: Below you will see a disciplinary plan similar to the Launch Pad Action plan. I am excited to give Child Watchers guidelines and the kids, our expectations for the evening. I believe this will help the night run smoothly. Please read over this plan, at PARENTS NIGHT OUT, you will be given a copy of these guidelines and will be asked to sign a paper that you have received these and also that both parents understand the guidelines and expectations of their child(ren) Please print this out and go over these guidelines with your children before you drop them off, that way they will know FROM YOU, what is expected as well.

5. Please note:*If a child is destructive to themselves, others, or property they will be dismissed immediately to their parents/guardians care. Actions involve, hitting, biting, and/or kicking another child. Parents will be called to pick up their child immediately. Please note, these offenses move a child directly to "STRIKE 3"*

Lastly, I want to say, again that I am thankful to each family for participating in Parents Night Out! I appreciate everyone working together to make a great night for the kids~!

Parents Night Out/Launch Pledge

1. **I will follow instructions**
2. **I will show respect to everyone**

(this includes not using God's name in vain)

3. **I will keep my hands and feet to myself**
4. **I will make wise choices**
5. **I will be responsible for my actions**

Disregarding any part of this pledge will result in disciplinary actions outlined on the below.

Very Important: If a child is destructive to themselves, others, or property they will be dismissed immediately to their parents/guardians care. Actions involve, hitting, biting, and/or kicking another child. Parents will be called to pick up their child immediately.

Disciplinary Actions

- The STRIKE program will be marked on the sign in sheet.
 - When you pick up your children, you will be informed if they received 2 strikes.
1. **No strikes- Child has no offenses and has followed all rules.**
 2. **Strike 1 - Child has one offense and has been warned/reminded of the Parents Night Out/Launch Pledge.**
 3. **Strike 2- Child has two offenses, has been warned, and will be placed in timeout, 1 minute per year of age.**
 4. **Strike 3- Child has three or more offenses. Child Watcher will notify Kelli Edwards, a phone call will be made to parents to come and pick up child immediately. Child should apologize to watcher/leader after PNO for their behavior.**
- If a child has gone to "Strike 3" once they will be welcomed back to Parents Night Out the next time.
 - If a child goes to "Strike 3" --2 times, child will not be allowed back to Parents Night Out for three months.
 - After the three month break from Parents Night Out, the child may return. If "Strike 3" happens another time, Kelli Edwards will have meeting with parents to decide whether the family should continue to participate in Parents Night Out.
